


Master's Rules

Rules for masters might sound like an oxymoron. There are lots of rules for servants online, but rules for masters are scarcer than hen's teeth. I felt a need for such a list to help a husband/master be a good and godly one. Remember, we have a Master in heaven. I hope the following will prove a blessing in your new-found relationship:

1. Open doors for her, treat her like a gracious woman. The old term, 'chivalry' fits here.
2. Stop what you are doing and devote attention to her.
3. Choose to delight in the 'wife of your youth'. Such is a command in Scripture and shows such delight is a choice, not just a feeling. Act accordingly and the feelings will follow.
4. What appears to please her desires? Pursue them!
5. Take the lead intimately.
6. Protect her. Don't let her go off to an abusive work environment. You take care of it, don't make her.
7. Protect her in any friendships. She needs friends, but not all are good. If she has a friend who bad-mouths her own husband, end it. Keep an eye on internet relationships.
8. Use a leash on her collar (in private), very therapeutic for both of you. Such play enforces the master/servant arrangement you have chosen to walk in.
9. **Pray constantly for God to make you the kind of man you need to be for your wife/servant – for courage, strength and wisdom.**
10. Require some intimate duties daily.
11. Remember your wife is the weaker vessel and consider her dignities and counsel, but you are the master. Your marital relationship is not a democracy. The ultimate decision is in your hands.
12. For this relationship to thrive, you must be VERY open. Share your feelings with each other. That is how you can see how to wisely proceed.
13. Show appreciation of the service your wife does.
14. Don't ignore disobedience, deal with it appropriately. This whole relationship will fall or stand with neglect or follow-through here.
15. You married her because you wanted her. Make use of her. Grab, touch, gaze, uncover and do so on a regular basis. If you want her to greet you with nothing but the collar on, give her the command!
16. It is the man's duty to provide for his wife's/servant's basic needs. Provide for her. No Mr. Moms here.
17. Oversee what your wife/servant is learning/studying. You are the head (both spiritual and natural). If you see her starting to get into something like Scientology, end it.
18. Consider the farmer who has an expensive tractor. He takes real good care of it and its maintenance, for his livelihood depends on it and he has invested a lot in it. Your wife/servant is the most precious possession you could have. More so than that tractor to the farmer. **Take good care of her!**

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
